

Introduction – The purpose of this note is to provide installation instructions and comments on a patch for the CQ/X Client software. The patch applies to version 1.7.5 of the software and is provided to implement enhancements and fix the problems described below.

Previous Patches – This is the second patch for version 1.7.5. Users of version 1.7.4 that have installed all of the patches for that version and patch 175-01 can apply this patch without downloading version 1.7.5. Other users should first download a full copy of version 1.7.5 from www.no5w.com and then apply Patch 175-01 to bring their software up-to-date prior to applying Patch 175-02.

Installation – In addition to these notes the zip file associated with this patch contains a setup file for automatically installing the patch in C:\ProgramFiles\CWSoft\CQXClient\. **WARNING: Please note that the setup file assumes that you have installed the program in C:\Program Files\CWSoft\.** If this is not the case you can still run the setup but following this you will need to manually copy each of the files to their corresponding directories in your location. Here's a list of the files contained in this patch and a description of where they will be installed.

File	Installation
TQP.DLL	This file is the DLL that handles all of the state QSO parties. It replaces the file of the same name in the Contest Definitions subdirectory which in the standard installation will be C:\Program Files\CWSoft\CqxClient\ContestDefns
ConList.dat	This file is a list of all of the supported contests and the main files that support them. It replaces the file of the same name in the Contest Definitions subdirectory which in the standard installation will be C:\Program Files\CWSoft\CqxClient\ContestDefns
Subdirectory TennesseeQSOParty	This new subdirectory of the Contest Definitions subdirectory contains files to support the Tennessee QSO Party. In the standard installation it is installed as C:\Program Files\CWSoft\CqxClient\ContestDefns\TennesseeQSOParty\
Subdirectory TNQP_Maps	This new subdirectory of the Maps subdirectory contains a map file to support the Tennessee QSO Party. In the standard installation it is installed as C:\Program Files\CWSoft\CqxClient\Maps\TNQP_Maps\

Problems Addressed/Enhancements – The following problems/enhancements are addressed.

Problem/Enhancement	Description
Tennessee QSO Party Support	Support was added for the Tennessee QSO Party. Note: There is a bonus multiplier rule that remains to be implemented.
Location of Countdown form	The countdown form was being placed off of the screen.
